WATERCOLOR PAINTS: (Winsor Newton Artist Watercolor, .17 fl. Oz. or Cotman Watercolors):

Cadmium yellow (lemon color)	Raw sienna
Cadmium red pale	Alizarin crimson
Prussian blue	Ultramarine blue
Burnt Sienna	Burnt umber
Designer gouache-Permanent white	

BRUSHES:

Round, Princeton Art & Brush Co. 4050R #16
¼” shorthaired bristle brush, for scrubbing (Lowe Cornell Series 2015, #2)
Script liner, Low Cornel Series 7050, #2

PAPER:

2-100% rag sheets of 140 lb. cold press, 22” x 30” (Arches), available from teacher in class

OTHER SUPPLIES: Rubber cement remover

Drawing pencils: 2B (each)
Sponges (square kitchen type and small cosmetic type)
2-small containers for water (Cool Whip type)
1-small spray bottle for water
Roll of 1” masking tape
