

## PSAT Testing Opportunity for Home School Students

Home school students who live in Northside ISD attendance boundaries and whose current instructional level is Grade 10 or 11 are eligible to take the PSAT being administered at the Northside ISD Student Services Building on October 14, 2009.

Students wishing to participate must provide:

- the completed registration form
- proof of residence in Northside ISD (such as a utility bill showing parent name and residence address)
- a picture ID for the student (preferably government issued license or ID)
- the non-refundable administrative fee (\$10.00 cash or money order only, no personal checks)

Deadline for registration is Friday, September 18<sup>th</sup>. Applications must be presented to the Testing & Evaluation Dept. located in the Patrick Teicher Student Services Building at 5651 Grissom Road with the \$10.00 fee (cash or money order only, no personal checks accepted), proof of residence, and identification.

The PSAT test date is Wednesday October 14, 2009. All home school students will test at the Patrick Teicher Student Services Building located at 5651 Grissom Road, 78238.

Students must report to the test site no later than 8:00 that morning. Students will need to have with them the same picture ID that was used for registration. The test should be completed by noon, and a telephone will be made available to students if they need to call for a ride home.
